What is a Distinguished Club?

- Strong engaged membership.
- Demonstrated leadership by Club Officers.
- Members Pathway's level submitted via Club central.
- Club Officers list.
 - June 30, 2021.
- 4 Club Officer Trained in Phase 1 & 2.
- Membership minimum payment of 8 to TI
 - September 30, 2021.
- Meet the required membership number or 20 members.

The Distinguished Club Program reflects a club's service to members. A club can achieve 5 or more Distinguished Club Goals; a combination of education, membership, training and administration goals.

Aspects of a Distinguished Club

Strong engaged membership

- Members engaged in Pathways.
- Speeches based on Pathways projects.
- Pathway's level being achieved.
- Completed Pathways level submitted via Club Central.
- Encourage members to work through their Toastmaster journey.

Aspects of a Distinguished Club

Demonstrated leadership

- Club Officers.
 - List submitted to TI via Club Central by June 30, 2021.
 - Attend training.
 - Phase 1 (June – August)
 - Phase 2 (November – February).
- Members taking on meeting roles.



Aspects of a Distinguished Club

Membership payments on time to TI.

- Minimum of 8 membership payment.
- Submit to TI before September 30, 2021.

Meet the required membership number or 20 members.

- Net new 5 members over base.
- New, dual or reinstated members.



Distinguished Club Points by Dec 2021

Pathways Levels submitted to TI	Ongoing, via Club Central	1 to 6
New members added - 8 new members	4 new members 4 more new members	2

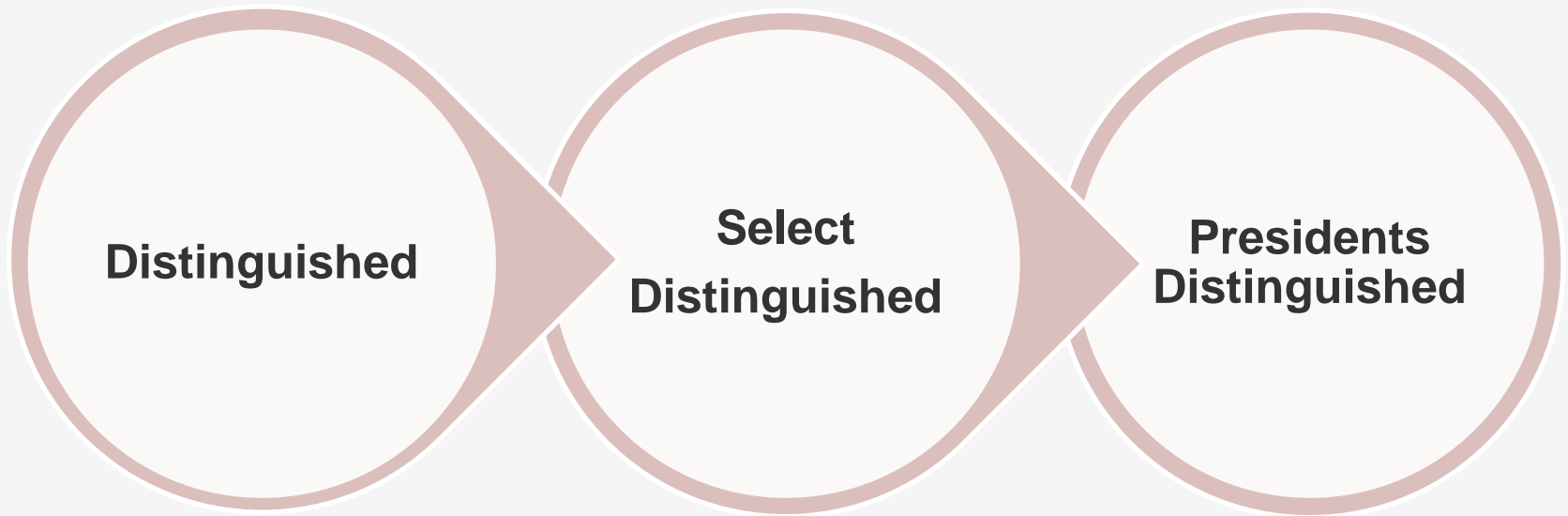
Your club may need more than 8 members to meet the Required number of members by June 30th.
