WHAT IS ACCEPTED AS PROOF OF VACCINATION?



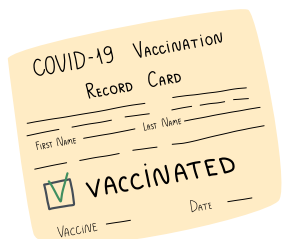
PRINTED VACCINATION RECORD

A printed copy of the Ministry of Health vaccination record received on day of vaccination. Proof of two doses is required. 14 day waiting period after second dose is required to be considered fully vaccinated.



PDF VACCINATION RECORD

The Ministry of Health vaccination record received on day of vaccination can be shown via PDF or smartphone. Proof of two doses is required. 14 day waiting period after second dose is required to be considered fully vaccinated.



OUTSIDE PROVINCES VACCINE RECORDS

If you are traveling from outside of Ontario, your provincial immunization record will be accepted. Proof of two doses plus 14 day waiting period must be shown.
