

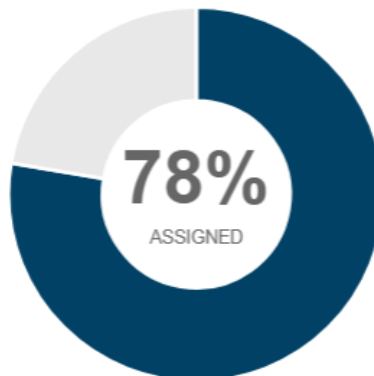


District 86 Toastmasters Located in Southwestern and Central Ontario, Canada

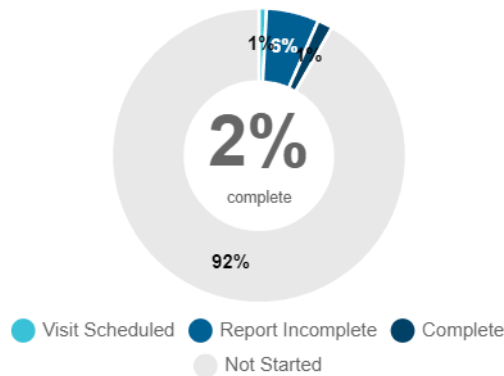
Division and Area Director Training
